PRACTICING GRATITUDE

Before you begin your prayer exercise, I suggest that you approach God with a heart and mind of thanksgiving for all that Jesus has already done! Thankfulness takes the sting out of all adversity. That is why God instructed us to " Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."
(1 Thessalonians 5:18)

There is an element of mystery in this transaction. You give thanks (regardless of your circumstances).

This is a spiritual act of obedience to God! But when you don't know God intimately, such an act of obedience can seem almost irrational and even impossible to do – Thanking God in the midst of hardship! Nevertheless those who obey God in this way are undeniably blessed, even though their difficulties may still remain.

Listen to what God says;
"Those who sacrifice thank offerings honour me, and to the blameless. I will show them my salvation." (Psalm 50:23)

The negative focus on our situation can lead us to eventually give up to the temptation of worry and concern.

The truth is, the continuous focus on your problem, will only strengthen your faith in your problem, more than you would have strengthened your faith in the healing that has already been provided for you in Christ!

Give thanks - Always!



Instead, let thankfulness open your heart to God's Presence and your mind to His thoughts.

You may still be in the same place with the same set of circumstances, but as you practice thankfulness, it is as if a Light has been switched on, enabling you to see from God's own perspective.

Precious, understand that it's the Light of His Presence that Removes the sting from adversity!

In everything, Give thanks!



Wonderful Example:

Here is an example of a grateful heart in action in this letter:

Dear Lord,

You know how I am struggling and how bleak everything looks right now. I am not only finding it difficult to pray, it' is nearly impossible for me to be grateful and not to be bitter all the time. Yet I know that my emotions are deceiving.

They reflect only a portion of the whole story. 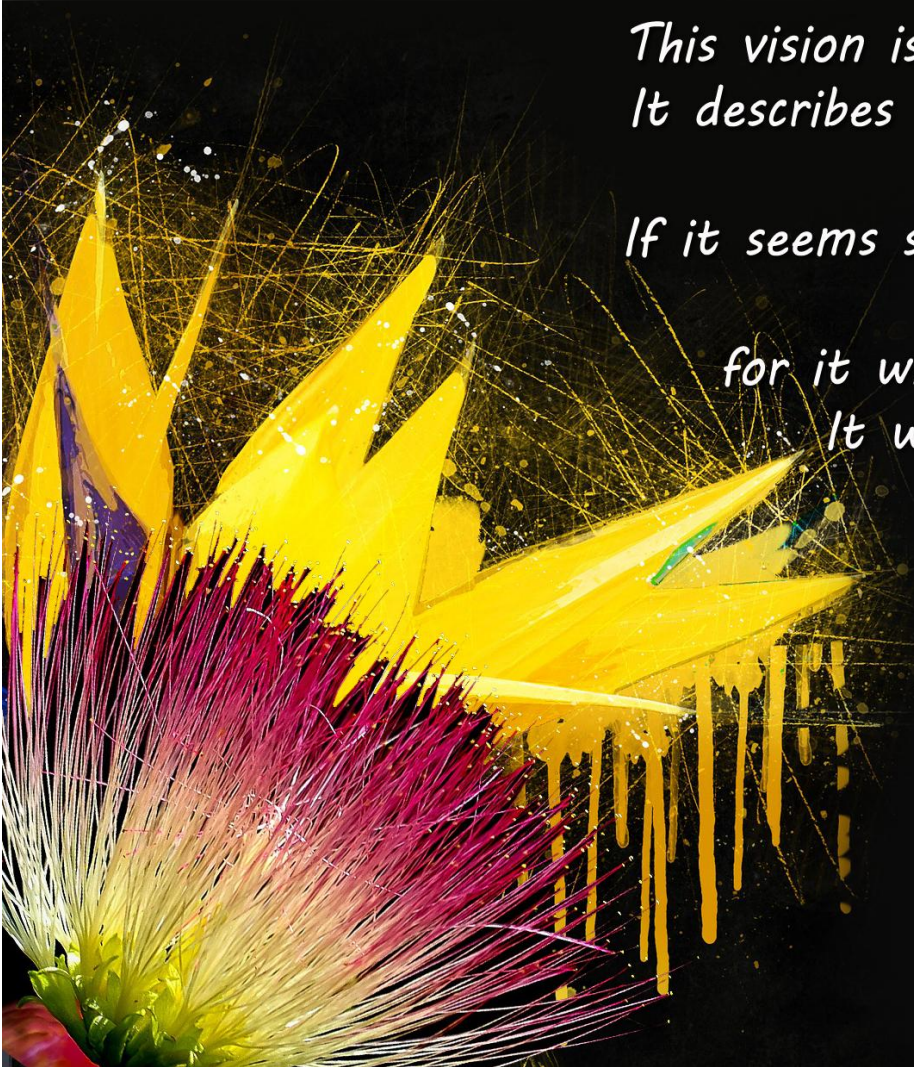




